Lesson 1: Why My Choices Matter

**READ IT!**

(VERSE OF THE DAY)

*“Walk with the wise and become wise; associate with fools and get in trouble” (Proverbs 13:20).*

**DO IT!**

(SERVING)

Pause for a moment and think of another teenager you know who consistently makes wise choices. Send that person a short, two-sentence text or email letting them know that you notice their good choices and want to have that same kind of wisdom yourself.

**PRAY IT!**

(PRAY FOR...)

Think about a decision you need to make, then pray this: “Please help me make a wise choice, Jesus. I want to follow the path that honors you.”

**LOVE IT!**

(GETTING CLOSER TO JESUS)

Here’s something Jesus said to a woman who had made bad choices sexually, in John 8:10-11: “Where are your accusers? Didn’t even one of them condemn you?... Neither do I. Go and sin no more.” Today, confess a bad choice to Jesus, and ask for his forgiveness. Then receive his “Neither do I” for yourself.

**LIVE IT!**

(WORSHIP)

Older people are often really wise! All throughout the Bible, older people are encouraged to share their wisdom with young people. Who’s an older adult you know? This week ask that person: “What are two pieces of advice you would give me as I move through my teenage years?” As a way to honor God’s wisdom, do something today that puts into practice the advice you heard.
